

About the Department of International Legal Assistance

The Department of International Legal Assistance at the Supreme Court of the Canton of Zurich represents the central authority for legal assistance in civil and commercial matters within the canton (state) of Zurich. The department is responsible for entering, checking, and the transmission of foreign requests for legal assistance, the coordination of legal proceedings between the canton of Zurich and foreign countries, and ensuring support for local authorities (primarily the chambers of the Supreme Court and the cantonal district courts) for the execution of requests for legal assistance abroad.

In the classical sense of word, international legal assistance covers acts like the service of judicial and non-judicial documents, the hearing of witnesses, the edition of documents, and other information in connection with ongoing proceedings.

Explicit notification is hereby made that the Department of International Legal Assistance is not responsible for the supply of general legal information or any private submissions. All questions in connection with court practices in the canton of Zurich, or legal questions which do not refer to international legal assistance, or an ongoing case treated by this department should therefore be addressed either to the usual law information centers or to private legal advisers and law offices.

Status requests by parties or their representatives should in general be submitted to the authorities which are responsible for a specific case. Those competent authorities will then contact our department if necessary. Information by phone is only provided to official authorities or authorized representatives.
